## **Award Process:**

The Foundation awards scholarships based on the following criteria:

## 1. Application submission on or before the deadline

Reviewed by Financial Aid Staff and Foundation Staff on 11/4/2024

## 2. Eligibility of each applicant for the scholarships they selected in the application

In cases where one or more applicants meet criteria 1 and 2, the Foundation's Scholarship Committee also considers *GPA, ACT, high school or community involvement in organizations, and volunteerism and may also consider financial need.* Applicants are ranked, and awardees are selected on a point system by a committee of faculty, support staff, and administrators at SAU Tech. In the case of a tie, the Foundation staff may participate in award decisions.
